John Williams of Austin College and Planned Parenthood of North Texas are hosting a lunch in Sherman “to learn about the health services available to low income women in Grayson County.” The lunch will take place in Kelly’s Restaurant located in Kelly’s Square on June 17th from 11:30 am – 1 pm.

This lunch is a fundraising and promotional effort of Planned Parenthood, the Nation’s largest abortion provider. The Texoma Pro-Life Association mobilized its members to contact Kelly Square to let them know we oppose Planned Parenthood and do not want them in our community.
