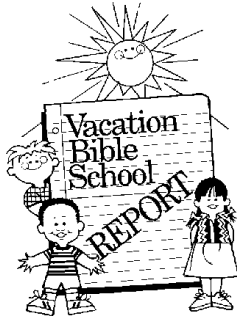

This is the theme for Pastor Mattil's messages here at Grace this summer. This series will begin today and continue through the month of August.

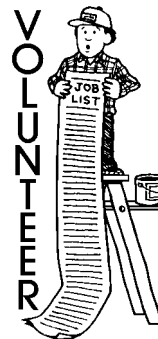


Name Tags
