2007 Denison Great Days of Service September 26-29

"Denison Great Days of Service will commence with a brief service of worship at First Christian Church (800 West Woodard), scheduled for 7:00 a.m. All volunteers are invited to attend. This will be followed with a breakfast. During this time representatives from Texoma Medical Center and Grayson County Health Department will be presented with the baby blankets for distribution to parents of newborn infants through these agencies. Thank to the quilt ladies here at Grace for making 60 blankets.

Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday, we will be working in concert with Habitat for Humanity to frame a home under construction at 218 East Hull Street. You need not be a skilled carpenter. Workers need not be present every day—they will take you whenever you can come! A supervisor will be on hand to instruct volunteers. Bring a hammer and a tape measure and join in this cooperative venture. We hope to have the house "dried in" by Saturday.

Wednesday at 9:30 a.m. volunteers will meet at Parkside Baptist Church in Denison to assemble care packages and deliver them to nursing home residents in Denison. We hope to visit over 300 residents, and transportation from Parkside will be provided.

Grace has been asked to provide volunteers to collect food and monetary donations at Albertsons in Denison on Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. All food collected will go to Helping Hands, the Grayson County Shelter and the Pottsboro Resale Barn. (On the Welcome Center in the narthex you will find paper bags with a list attached for items needed and a date to return the bags.)

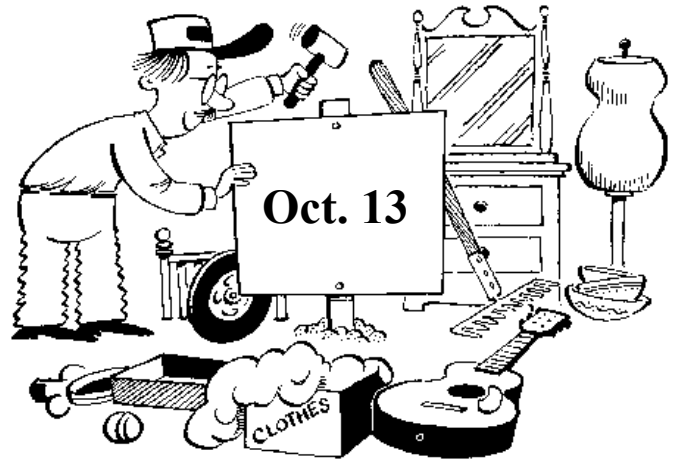
Read through the Bible in 2008
