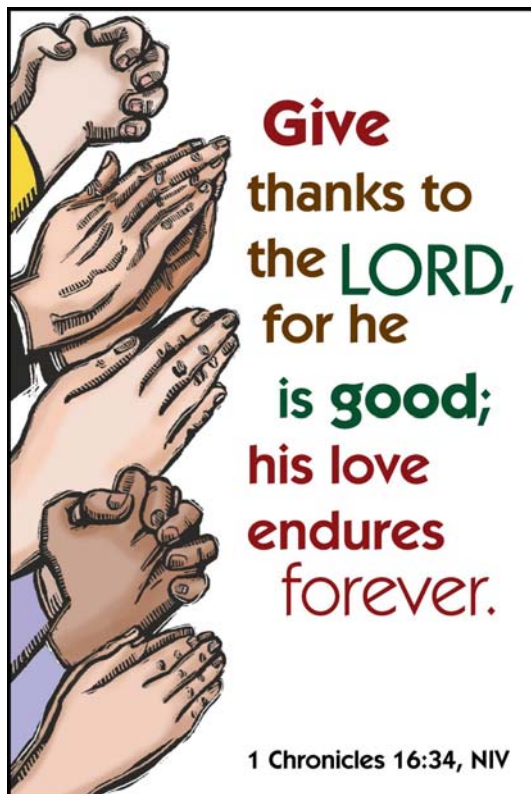


Weekly News & Events
